Last fall, we were introduced to an elderly woman named Aigul\*. She was deeply in debt, worked hard, & had very little money. She rented a small room & lived with her alcoholic daughter. Not long after we had met her, we learned that she had lost her job.

With Unto funds, we purchased some items & brought them to families in need. When we visited Aigul's home, she welcomed us warmly & invited us to sit down for tea.

Besides her daughter, there was also a friend of hers present, but lying in bed. As we sat at the table, we explained that the help we brought was sent by God, and that we were followers of Jesus Christ. Aigul woke her friend so she could join us. The woman was obviously uncomfortable & did not seem to like us; she could barely sit up & turned away as we spoke.

When we began talking about salvation & prayer, Aigul said, "Please pray for my friend—she gets sick whenever she eats." As we prayed, with her permission, I gently placed my hand on her stomach, which felt very hard. After the prayer, she quietly got up and left the room.

Then Aigul asked how she could believe in Jesus. After we explained the message of faith, she said she wanted to accept the Savior & begin attending a local home group!

On our next visit, Aigul claimed that she had witnessed two miracles from God. The first miracle: Providing her soap. In her words, "How did you know there was no soap in my house? I hadn't been able to buy any for a long time."

The second miracle came through her friend, who said: "After you prayed for me, I felt like eating again. I ate, my stomach didn't hurt, and I feel better."
