Ahmed was a successful professional in his country, yet during the pandemic, he was plagued by loneliness and addiction. Eventually, his addiction led him to prison. Upon his release, he moved to an area of the country where we were actively working and we happened to meet him. However, when we tried to get to know Ahmed better, he was never available or would refuse to receive us. This prompted members of the Cru team to offer humanitarian aid, provided by Unto®, (in Ahmed’s case, meals) to see if it would open a door to friendship and sharing the hope of Jesus. When we returned with the meals, he immediately welcomed us into his one-room home. Because he was underemployed, he was unable to support himself fully and was in critical need of food. Over time, these visits had a profound impact on Ahmed. Not only did he grow to see the importance of the local church who, assisted by our Cru staff, visited and cared for him regularly, but he also heard the Gospel message, and it touched his heart. He accepted the Lord Jesus as the Savior of his life, and he participated in the discipleship and spiritual growth processes that the Cru staff and our church partners have developed. Without the material help he received, we would not have had the opportunity to befriend Ahmed or share the Gospel message with him.

How exciting to receive stories like this from my counterpart on the ground in the Middle East. We regularly ship containers full of humanitarian aid there to assist the local Cru staff to gain access, credibility, and effectiveness (or “ACE”) in their ministries. Ahmed was one of the many people touched by our last container sent to his country. In my upcoming trip there in November, I hope to meet Ahmed in person. There are many more like him who have come to know Christ because humanitarian aid opened a door to the Good News. Thank you for your partnership which enables me to be a resource for staff teams ministering in the toughest places on earth!
